Luxperience ("we", "our", "us") is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, use, store, and disclose personal information in accordance with the **Privacy Act 1988** (Cth) and applicable data protection laws. By providing your personal information to us, you consent to the collection and processing of your personal data as described in this policy.

1. Collection of Personal Information

2. Purpose of Collection and Use

Your personal information may be used for the following purposes:

- Organising and managing events, exhibitions, promotions, publications, advertising, and sponsorships
- Addressing complaints, inquiries, investigations, or any legal or insurance claims involving you
- Processing and managing your participation in events, exhibitions, or other Luxperience activities

 Ensuring compliance with agreements, terms, and conditions, including those related to our events and services

We will only use your personal information for the purposes specified at the time of collection, or for other purposes as permitted under applicable law.

3. Disclosure of Personal Information

We may disclose your personal information to the following entities:

- Event organisers, co-exhibitors, and clients in relation to events, exhibitions, or promotions
- Our affiliates, subsidiaries, and related companies
- Insurers, venue organisers, and service providers (including contractors, event organisers, IT providers, and database administrators)
- Professional bodies, associations, or regulatory bodies with a legitimate interest in the information
- · Any third parties with a legal right to access your personal data

We will not sell, rent, or lease your personal information to third parties. Any disclosures will be made only when necessary to facilitate the services we provide to you, or when required by law.

4. International Transfers

We may transfer your personal information to sponsors and partners located outside of Australia. By providing your personal data, you consent to these international transfers.

5. Security of Personal Information

We take reasonable steps to ensure that your personal information is protected against unauthorised access, use, or disclosure. However, due to the inherent nature of the internet, we cannot guarantee the absolute security of data transmitted online. You acknowledge and accept the risks associated with online transmission and agree that Luxperience will not be held liable for any unauthorised access or breach of security.

6. Access and Correction

In accordance with the **Privacy Act 1988**, you have the right to:

- Request access to the personal information we hold about you
- Request correction of any inaccurate or incomplete personal data

7. Retention of Personal Information

We will retain your personal information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected, including for any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements. When your personal information is no longer needed, we will securely delete or anonymize it in accordance with applicable data retention policies.

8. Withdrawal of Consent

You have the right to withdraw your consent to the collection and use of your personal information at any time, subject to any legal or contractual obligations. If you wish to withdraw consent or have your personal information deleted, please contact us in writing. We will process such requests in accordance with applicable law.

9. Legal Rights

Under the **Privacy Act 1988**, you have the following rights in relation to your personal information:

- Right to withdraw your consent to processing at any time
